In accordance with City Ordinance No. 1119 the City would like to permit the use of camping trailers and recreational vehicles in areas of the City other than which are not camp grounds or trailer parks.

The City defines "camping trailers" as: "A vehicle equipped with wheels, and normally towed over the road behind an automobile or light truck...and equipped with an enclosure for sleeping while on vacation or other trips of short duration. Such camping trailers may also contain cooking, bath and sanitary equipment." The City defines "recreational vehicles" as: "vehicular type units primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use and which have their own motive power."

Camping Trailers/Recreational vehicles may be temporarily used as an overnight residence at the discretion of the City Building Inspector and will only be granted if:

- 1) The owner of the property where the vehicle will be located obtains a permit for the sum of \$15.00 from the City Inspector. The permit will designate the approved location for the trailer/vehicle and if available any connections to water/sewer pipes.
- 2) The permit does not exceed (7) seven days. The permit may be renewed one time for an additional (7) days and an additional \$15.00.
- 3) Such permit should be displayed on the trailer or recreational vehicle so that the City Inspector can see it.
- 4) The Inspector may deny the permit if it constitutes a nuisance, or poses a health or safety risk. The City Inspector may revoke the permit or renewal at any time if it constitutes a nuisance or health or safety risk.
- 5) The failure of the property owner, or their designated representative to remove the trailer or vehicle or any equipment or garage connected upon expiration or renewal expiration will result in the property owner being fined not more than \$100.00 for each day that it remains on the property.
- 6) Any person using a camping trailer or recreational vehicle as a residence within the City limits without first obtaining a permit will be fined not more than \$100.00 for each day that the trailer or vehicle is used.
