Ordinance No. 2542 Summary

On July 7, 2022, the City of De Soto, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 2542, levying a recently passed City Retailers' Sales Tax in the amount of three quarters of one percent (.75%) for City capital improvement projects, which tax replaces a former sales tax in the same amount and for the same purpose. Collection of the tax will begin on October 1, 2022 and end on September 30, 2032. ORDINANCE NO. 2542

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE QUARTERS OF ONE PERCENT (.75%) WITHIN THE CITY OF DE SOTO, KANSAS

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-187(e), the city of De Soto, Kansas (the "City"), submitted to the qualified electors of the City the question of levying a retailers' sales tax in the amount of .75% for a period of 10 years in the City, such tax to be collected by the Kansas Department of Revenue with the revenue returned to the City to be used for financing capital improvement projects, including but not limited to, improvements of the City's streets and sidewalks, as well as the City's water, sewer, and drainage systems; and

WHEREAS, at a special question election held in the City on June 21, 2022, more than a majority of the qualified electors of the City voting at the election on the question voted in favor of the proposition; and

WHEREAS, collection of such sales tax will commence on October 1, 2022 and end on September 30, 2032.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DE SOTO, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A city retailers' sales tax in the amount of three quarters of one percent (.75%) is hereby levied in the City in accordance with K.S.A. 12-187(e) and K.S.A. 12-187(f). Such retailer's sales tax shall take effect on October 1, 2022, or the earliest date thereafter that the Kansas Department of Revenue can begin collecting such tax, and will expire 10 years thereafter.

Section 2. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Kansas Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce, and collect such tax.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official City newspaper. The City Clerk is hereby directed to deliver to the State Director of Taxation a certified copy of this ordinance, an affidavit of publication of this ordinance and a copy of the canvass of votes at such election prepared by the Johnson County Election Commissioner.
