### KDOT - 103RD STREET CONSTRUCTION

Road closures began mid June on West 103rd Street between the Sunflower Baseball Fields and Astra Parkway.



- Closed/No Access: West 103rd Street between the Sunflower Baseball Fields and Astra Parkway.
- Closed/No Through Traffic: 103rd Street from Astra Parkway to String Town Road.
- Open through July 31: The Sunflower Baseball Fields will remain open and accessible on West 103rd Street via Evening Star Road.
- No Access: To 103rd Street from Edgerton Road or Sunflower Road.

## OTTAWA STREET OPEN

The Ottawa Street Bridge Reconstruction Project is officially complete!

Prior to construction, this two-lane stretch of road was approximately 24 feet in total width with no shoulder or sidewalk; the reconstruction project widened the road to 32 feet (two 11-foot travel lanes and two 5-foot bike lanes).

These improvements will provide better multimodal access to Riverfest park and the many events hosted there each year.
