Ordinance No. 2441 Summary

On March 15, 2018, the City of De Soto, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 2441, authorizing the temporary use of funds from the Electric Utility Fund for purchase of a City dump truck, and related equipment, with the funds used being paid back to the Fund over the course of five years at an annualized interest rate of 2.5 percent. ORDINANCE NO. 2441

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY USE OF UP TO \$124,434 FROM THE ELECTRIC UTILITY FUND TO PURCHASE CITY TRUCK AND RELATED EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2003, the City adopted Ordinance 2030 to permit the Governing Body -- with a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority vote -- to use all or a portion of the principal of the Electric Utility Fund to “enable the citizens of De Soto security for long term planning and growth and to assure uninterrupted and continued services which are provided by the City during the City’s growth.”; and

WHEREAS, the City’s temporary use of the Electric Utility Fund -- in lieu of obtaining private financing -- for financing the purchase of a dump truck, and related equipment, until such time as the street department budget can repay such amount will save the City finance costs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DE SOTO, KANSAS:

Section 1. Authorization. The Governing Body hereby authorizes use of up to \$124,434 from the City’s Electric Utility Fund for purchase of a dump truck, and related equipment, recommended by City Staff, said funds to be repaid over the course of five years, under the oversight of the City Administrator, with an annualized interest rate of 2.5 percent, commencing in 2019.

Section 2. Policy Objective. As required by Ordinance No. 2030, the Governing Body hereby determines that such use of the Electric Utility Fund is consistent with the following policy objective contained in Ordinance No. 978:

It is the policy objective of the Governing Body that the creation of such investment fund shall enable the citizens of De Soto security for long term planning and growth and to assure uninterrupted and continued services which are

provided by the City during the City's growth.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.

PASSED by the Governing Body of the City of De Soto, Kansas by a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority, and approved by the Mayor on the 15th day of March, 2018.
