ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE REVIEW

The City Council is actively reviewing the regulations regarding the ownership of Pit Bull breeds within De Soto's animal control ordinance. The Council is considering whether to maintain its current policy prohibiting the ownership of Pit Bull dogs or revise the code to permit ownership of this specific breed.
