On September 5, 2024, the City of De Soto, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 2625 prohibiting parking in certain designated areas on 82nd Street within the City of De Soto, Kansas.

ORDINANCE NO. 2625

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON PORTIONS OF 82ND STREET

WHEREAS, Article 2 of Chapter XIV of the City Code contains Local Traffic Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City needs continual access to its sewer lift station located in the vicinity of Sunset Drive and the terminus of 82nd Street and, therefore, wishes to prohibit parking in the area of the lift station.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of De Soto:

Section 1. In accordance with K.S.A. 8-2002, the Governing Body hereby adopts the following new section 14-209 of Article 2 of Chapter XIV of the City Code:

14-211. Restriction of Parking on 82nd Street.

In accordance with K.S.A. 8-2002, the Governing Body does hereby prohibit all parking on the north and south sides of 82nd Street, beginning 55 from the western right of way line of Sunset Drive at 82nd Street and ending at the western terminus of 82nd Street, where the City has installed a gate.

Section 2: Signage to be ordered. City Staff is hereby directed to procure no parking signs to be installed as soon as possible after the effective date hereof.

Section 3: Repealer. Any Ordinances or Code provisions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the City's official newspaper.
